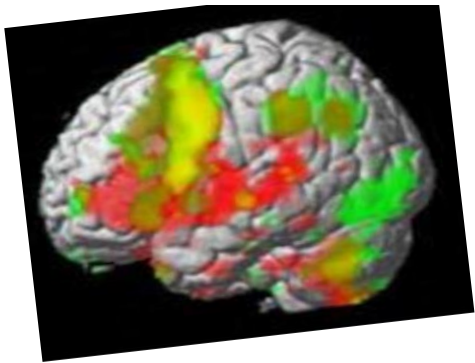


VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

The *Reading Strategies Program* at Georgia State University is looking for healthy adults to participate in a research study looking to better understand how the brain functions during reading.

Qualifications:

- Male or female, ages 18 to 50
- Native English speaker
- Right-handed
- No major psychiatric or neurological disorder
- No permanent metal in or on body
- No pacemaker, cochlear implant, permanent hearing aid
- Not claustrophobic
- Healthy (no heart or neurological diseases, history of seizures, other organ failure, sickle cell anemia, high or low blood pressure)

Study Includes:

- Reading and reading-related tests lasting up to 3 hours per session
- 9 functional Magnetic Resonance Imaging (fMRI) brain scan sessions lasting up to 1 hour each
- 4 Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS) sessions lasting up to 45 minutes each
- Reading sessions can be done virtually and/or at Georgia State University/Georgia Institute of Technology Center for Advanced Brain Imaging
- Brain imaging sessions will take place at Georgia State University/Georgia Institute of Technology Center for Advanced Brain Imaging in Atlanta
- 5 visits will be done over the course of 3 months

Receive up to \$235, based on number of sessions completed (minimum \$25)
